Animal Science

This course will provide the student with principles in animal Science focusing on areas of livestock production, breed identification, nutrition, and reproduction.

This course meets WHS graduation and UC/CSU "D" credit for admissions



Veterinary Science

This course is designed to provide students with an opportunity to study the science of veterinary medicine, including animal anatomy and physiology, animal health, veterinary office procedures, and cause/prevention of disease.

Students will learn various veterinary handling and restraint skills.

This course meets WHS graduation and UC/CSU "D" credit for admissions



Companion Animal Care

This course is designed to teach students about companion and small animal care, management, nutrition, behavior, and domestication. This course will help students prepare for careers in the veterinary and animal-science fields.

This course meets WHS graduation and UC/CSU "G" credit for admissions
